Bars	Dancers	Formations
1,2 3,4	1C 1C 2C	SET CAST to 2 <sup>nd</sup> place
5-8	1L 1M 2,3C	move up HALF FIGURE of EIGHT round 1C place HALF FIGURE of EIGHT round 3C place SET and CROSS RIGHT end with 2M and 3L facing out
9-12	2M,3L	dance clockwise round set to change places
while	2L,1M and 1I	L,3M SET, CROSS RIGHT diagonally end with 1C facing out
13-16	Repeat bars 9-	12 but with 1C dancing anti-clockwise to change places
17-20	Repeat bars 9-	12 but with 3M and 2L dancing clockwise to change places
21-24	2,1,3C	end 2,1,3 on own side TURN RIGHT ending in centre of set
25-32	2,1,3C	ALLEMANDE

Repeat with a new top couple.
