| 3,4 | 1 C | CAST to $2^{\text {nd }}$ place |
|  | 2C | move up |
| 5-8 | 1L | HALF FIGURE of EIGHT round 1C place |
|  | 1M | HALF FIGURE of EIGHT round 3C place |
|  | 2,3C | SET and CROSS RIGHT end with 2 M and 3 L facing out |
| 9-12 | 2M,3L | dance clockwise round set to change places |
| while | 2L, 1M and | 1L,3M <br> SET, CROSS RIGHT diagonally end with 1C facing out |
| 13-16 | Repeat bars | 9-12 but with 1 C dancing anti-clockwise to change places |
| 17-20 | Repeat bars | $9-12$ but with 3 M and 2 L dancing clockwise to change places end $2,1,3$ on own side |
| 21-24 | 2,1,3C | TURN RIGHT ending in centre of set |
| 25-32 | 2,1,3C | ALLEMANDE |

| $9-16$ | $1,2,3 \mathrm{C}$ | CIRCLE 6 hands LEFT and BACK. |
| $17-20$ | $1,2 \mathrm{C}$ | RIGHTS and LEFTS <br> (normal, cross the set to begin) |
| $21-24$ | $2,3 \mathrm{C}$ | RIGHTS and LEFTS <br> (start with right hands ON THE SIDES) |
